**Weekly Update on SMP M20 Programmed Work
Works Information
Monday 22 July to 28 July 2019**

Work to reduce congestion and improve journey times continues this week with narrow lanes and a reduced speed limit of 50mph both coast and London bound 24/7. Free recovery service and speed enforcement are in place to ensure drivers and road workers safety.

Monday 22 to 28 July (inclusive)

22 July - there will be a full overnight closure of the M20 coastbound and London bound between junctions 2 and 4, and the M26 junction 2a to the M20. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A20.

23 July – there will be a full overnight closure of the M20 coastbound between junction 2 and 4, and the M26 junction

On Friday 26 July there will be a full weekend closure of the M20 London bound entry slip at junction 4, from 8pm through till 6am on Monday 29 July. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the next available junction.

28 July – there will be a full overnight closure of the M20 London bound between junctions 4 and 2. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A20. This closure is overnight only between 8pm and 6am.

In addition to these closures detailed above there will be various lane 1 & 2 closures on the main M20 London bound and coastbound.
